# Impacts (keeping it short)

- Climate change emissions (due to automobile dependency)
- Local air quality (criteria air contaminants)
- Energy consumption
- Health: heart disease, obesity, diabetes, social isolation, mental illness, traffic injuries and fatalities, etc.
- Loss of social capital
- City finances due to subsidies
- Personal finances – risk related to fuel prices
